ENTRY INFORMATION

Pre-entries open on **10/16/17** and close on 11/4/17 by **postmark**. **No overnight, phone or email entries.**

Day-of entries will be taken from 7:00AM until 7:30AM each day if space is available.

Entries will not be accepted without payment. \$25 charge for returned checks.

Fees - Ducks - \$30.00 Sheep - \$40.00 Cattle—\$50.00

Junior / Novice - \$20.00 per class

Additional \$5.00 per class for same day entries.

No refunds after the closing date unless runs can be filled from a wait list.

POLICIES:

- This trial shall be run under all ASCA rules and regulations. See asca.org for current rules.
- Use official ASCA Stock Trial entry form: <https://goo.gl/hd4aHo>
- Non-ASCA registered dogs – In order to have ASCA qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of application for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type, the Service membership, is required). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. For more information and applications go to: <https://goo.gl/1hFQHu>
- Each individual is responsible for any damage caused by himself, his family or his dog while in the trial arena or on the trial grounds. Livestock replacement costs are as follows: Ducks - \$50.00, Sheep - \$350.00, Cattle - \$1,200.00. ASCA, WAV and Keepstone Farm assume no responsibility for any accident or injury.
- Substitutions allowed per ASCA Stockdog rules.
- Bitches in season will run in order. They should be crated away from trial arenas when not competing.
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing.
- Entry confirmation will be sent by email. Please include your email address.
- Trial committee will draw run order prior to the trial.
- Entry fees will only be refunded if request is received before pre-entry closing date or if runs can be filled from a wait list.

AWARDS (including but not limited to):

Ribbons for all qualifying runs. Ribbons for 1st - 4th place, each stock, each trial.

Rosettes for HIT Aussie, HIT Other Breed, HIT Started Aussie and HIT Open Aussie.

Special Rosette for any dog completing a WTCH.
