AUSTRALIAN CATTLE DOGS PREFERRED – NOTE EARLY OPENING DATE.

Otherwise, open to all Herding Group dogs, eligible Working Group, Terrier Group and FSS breeds, Herding breeds eligible to compete in the conformation Miscellaneous Class, and dogs of these breeds with ILP numbers as defined by the AKC Herding Rules and Regulations.

Saturday & Sunday, June 22-23, 2019

Events will be held outdoors at: Scarlets Mill, 2384 Hay Creek Road, Birdsboro, PA

Entries open: AUSTRALIAN CATTLE DOGS: Friday, March 29, 2019. All entries received before this date will be returned. Entries will be accepted on a first received basis.

ALL OTHER BREEDS: Wednesday, April 24, 2019. All entries received before this date will be returned. Entries will be accepted on a first received basis.

Entries close: Wednesday, June 5, 2019, at 5:00 PM. After this time, entries cannot be accepted, canceled, or substituted.

Entries limited to 50 runs per judge per day, with a maximum of 20 cattle runs and/or 35 duck runs. Drawing for running order will be made at Secretary's home on Wednesday, June 5, 2019 at 6 PM.

ENTRY FEES

Ducks: Trial Courses A & B: \$55 per entry
(Course A duck arena is approx 50x100)

Sheep: Trial Courses A & B: \$55 per entry

Cattle: Trial Courses A & B: \$65 per entry

(Course A sheep/cattle arena is approx 100x200)

(The A Course arenas all run opposite of the diagrams in the AKC Regs)

(Course B outrun is approximately 50% of the maximum for all 3 stock and all classes)

For each Test class all qualifying dogs will receive green rosettes with white button and white center streamer.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

TRIAL SITE will be open from 7 AM to ½ hour after the event ends. Dogs may not be left overnight. There is little shade or protection from the weather at the site. Please bring shade cloth, tents, and chairs with you.

FOOD: Food may be available on site. There are restaurants approximately 15 minutes from the trial site.

DOGS ON GROUNDS: ***You are responsible for picking up after your dogs and disposing of waste in proper receptacles.*** All dogs present must be held on leash or otherwise restricted except when being judged. Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. Unentered dogs are not allowed in the trial areas.

PLEASE NOTE: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

ENTRY INFORMATION

If sending entries overnight, make sure to sign the waiver that allows them to leave packages without a signature. Requiring a signature will only delay receipt of your entries.

The Australian Cattle Dog Club of America, the Central Pennsylvania Australian Cattle Dog Club, Del Bay Herding Club, their officers and representatives, the Trial Chair, Secretary, Committee, and the owners of the trial site assume no responsibility for loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors' property and their dogs and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. Owners or handlers entering a dog in the Test or Trial do so at their own risk and also agree to abide by the Rules of The American Kennel Club and the most recent version of the AKC Herding Regulations.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY.

ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms (whoever may make such errors) and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print clearly and carefully the information on entry forms to eliminate errors.

DECLINED ENTRIES: The Australian Cattle Dog Club of America may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against the aforementioned mentioned club or any official thereof.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event a dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered class, disqualified, excused, by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the Test\Trial, no refund of entries will be made.

ALTERNATE LIST POLICIES: When entry limits are reached, all additional entries received prior to closing will be added to an alternates list. The alternates list will be used to fill vacancies that occur in the drawn running order, with the first available alternate entry replacing the first vacancy in the class entered.

BITCHES IN SEASON will run in catalog order for Trial classes. Please notify the Trial Secy before the beginning of the class if your bitch is in season.

No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same kind of stock under the same judge at any Test or Trial.

DIRECTIONS – PLEASE READ!

From I-78/I-80/Allentown: DUE TO RT 82 CLOSED SOUTH OF BIRDSBORO, THESE ARE ALTERNATE DIRECTIONS. Follow Rt 100 South to Rt 23. Turn right onto Rt 23 (Ridge Rd) and go to Elverson. Turn right onto Rt 82 (N Chestnut St/Elverson Rd). When you get to a 4 way stop, follow Rt 82 to the right. From there, go 4.8 miles through Geigertown (*Fire Station on the right*) to the stop sign. Turn LEFT at the stop sign. You have arrived at the trial site on the left after the turn (two stone pillars at entrance of drive). Please use second driveway on left (Rock Hollow Rd) for parking.

From the PA Turnpike exit 298: Take Route 10 North/Beckersville 0.6 miles, then turn RIGHT onto Joanna Rd. Go 0.9 miles to stop sign (at Joanna Store) and turn RIGHT. Go 0.4 miles to the stop sign and turn LEFT onto Route 82 North (Hay Creek Road/Twin Valley Rd). Go 4.8 miles through Geigertown (*Fire Station on the right*) to the stop sign. Turn LEFT at the stop sign. You have arrived at the trial site on the left after the turn (two stone pillars at entrance of drive). Please use second driveway on left (Rock Hollow Rd) for parking.

From Philadelphia Intl Airport to Morgantown: Merge onto I-95 S toward Delaware. Exit onto I-476 N (exit 7) toward Plymouth Meeting. Exit onto I-76 W (exit 16B) toward Valley Forge. Take Exit 298 (I-176, Rt 10, Morgantown/Reading). Follow directions above.

From NY/NJ/East: NJ Turnpike to exit 6 (PA Turnpike W). Merge onto NJ Turnpike Ext. NJ Turnpike Ext. becomes PA Turnpike W (I-76). Take Exit 298 (I-176, Rt 10, Morgantown/Reading). Follow directions above.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. I (we) will pay for any injuries or the replacement value in this event of serious injury to the livestock caused by my (our) dog. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us).
