Trial Secretary will contact you immediately if the trial fills and a waiting list is started.

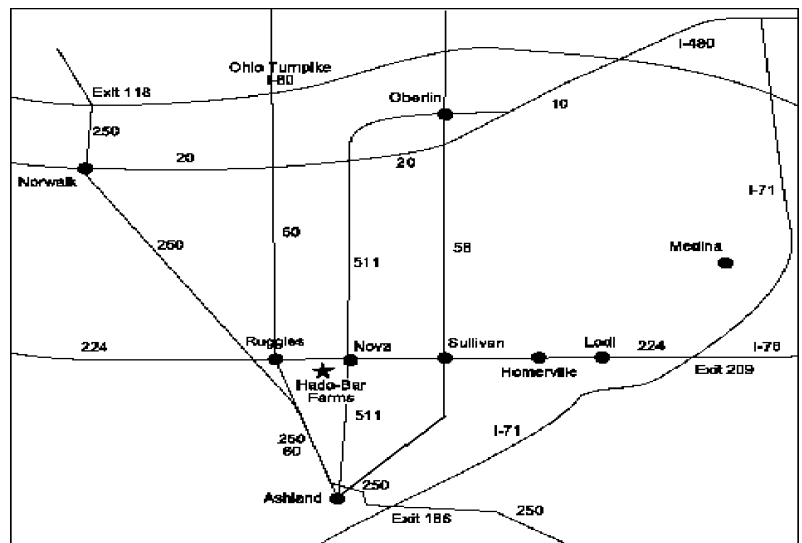
DIRECTIONS TO HADO-BAR FARM

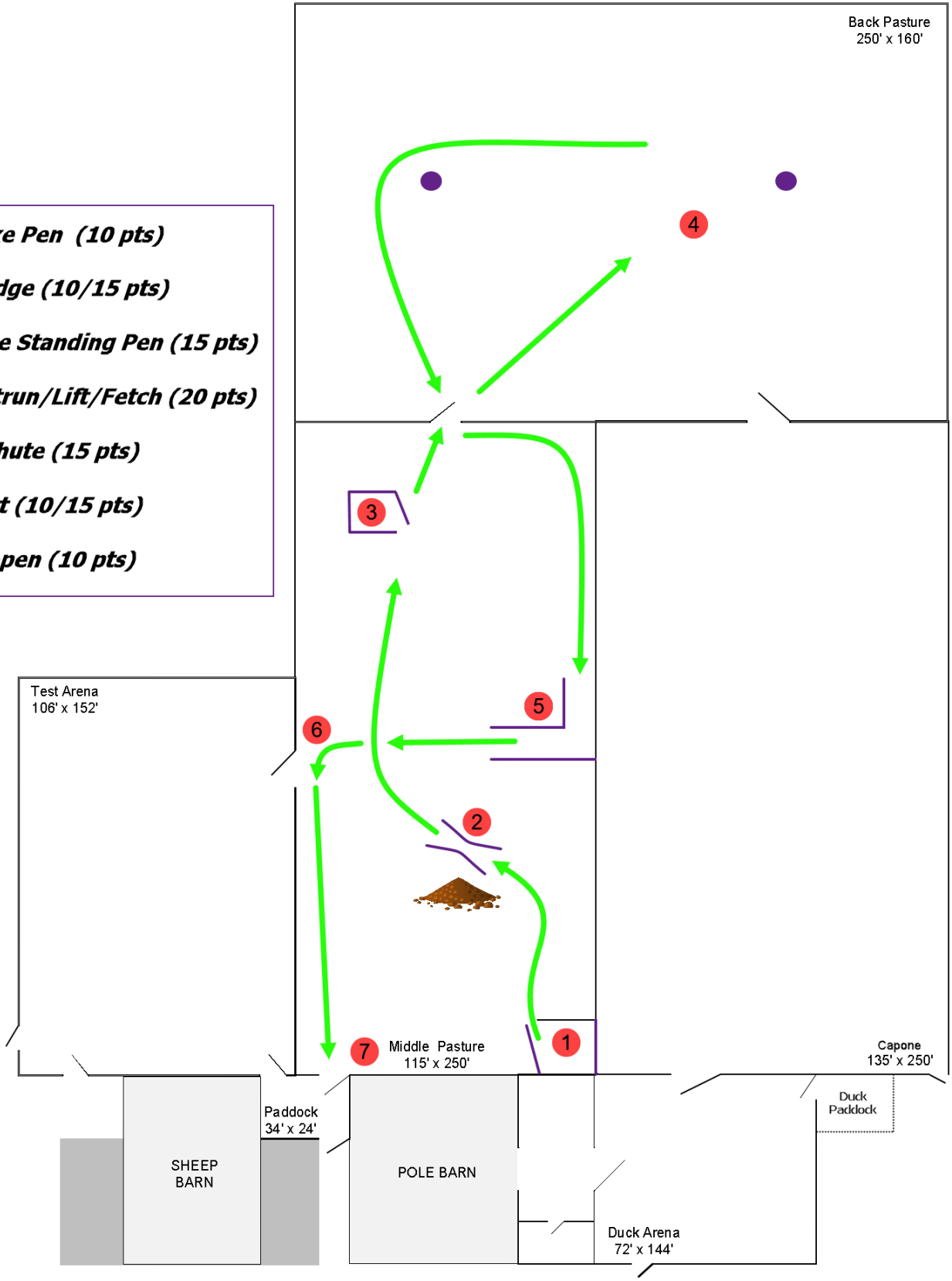

HERDING RANCH DOG - COURSE DESCRIPTION

MAY 18/19 2019

1) Take Pen (10 pts.)

10 Sheep are in the Take Pen attached to Capone Field. Team exhausts sheep out of pen.

- Level III: Handler may not enter pen to assist dog. Handler must stay on the outside of the pen and door.
- Level II: Handler may work on the inside of the pen door but may not go into pen itself.
- Level I: Handler may go anywhere to help assist removal of sheep.

2) Bridge (10/15 pts.)

Sheep are moved to and through "Bridge" set in Middle Field.

- Level III: Handler must stay at Take Pen door until sheep have exited "Bridge". Sheep can be held anywhere between the "Bridge" and the Free Standing Pen until Handler reaches Pen.
- Level II: Handler may move halfway between Take Pen and "Bridge". (A cone will be setting by compost pile to denote line) Handler may move past Cone and "Bridge" once Sheep have exited "Bridge". Sheep can be held anywhere between "Bridge" and Free Standing Pen until Handler reaches Pen.
- Level I: Handler may fetch/drive sheep to and through "Bridge". Handler may move anywhere in relation to sheep and "Bridge" except through the obstacle. Once through the obstacle, sheep move directly to the Free Standing Pen.

3) Free Standing Pen (15 pts.)

Sheep are moved into Free Standing Pen. Sheep are then taken out of the Pen and moved to the Back Pasture/PT Field Gate and put through.

Level III, II, I: Handlers may move anywhere around the pen in order to help move sheep into pen. Handlers do not need to hang onto pen, door or rope. Handlers may not move inside of pen door to help pull sheep in. All levels may fetch/drive to Back Pasture/PT Field Gate.

4) Outrun/lift/Fetch (20 pts.)

Hay/Grain will be set out on the north end of the Back Pasture/PT Field. Sheep may be fetch/driven to set out by all levels and then dog is called off to go to level appropriate cone. Once Outrun/Lift/Fetch is accomplished, all levels may fetch/drive sheep back to Middle Field Gate are put through.

- Level III: Handler and dog set up at cone placed on south end of field
- Level II: Dog is set at Handler's Cone; handler may move halfway to stock.
- Level I: Dog is set halfway between Handler's Cone and stock; handler may move to within 15 feet of stock

5) L Chute (15 pts.)

Sheep are moved along the fence that borders the Back Pasture/PT Field and then turn along fence that borders Capone Field to L Chute set midway down the fence. Sheep exit L Chute and are moved across the field to the bottom Test Arena/HT Field Gate to be put through.

- Level III: Handler stays at Back Pasture/PT Field gate until the sheep have exited the L Chute. Once sheep have exited Chute, handler may move directly to the Test Arena/HT Field Gate to help exhaust sheep.
- Level II: Handler may move halfway to L Chute (the corner of the field) and then must stay there until the sheep have moved through the Chute. Once the sheep have exited the Chute the handler can meet up and move with sheep or move directly to Test Arena/HT Field Gate.
- Level I: Handler may move with sheep along the line of travel but may not enter the L Chute.

6) Sort (10/15 pts.)

5 sheep will be exhausted into the Test Arena/HT Field.

- Level III: 5 collared sheep will be exhausted into Test Arena/HT Field. The judge will tell exhibitor which color prior to start of run. (Judge may remind handler of color if needed)
- Level II: 5 sheep are exhausted into Test Arena/HT Field. 3 of the sheep must be of the same collar color designated by judge.
- Level I: Any 5 sheep are exhausted into Test Arena/HT Field.

7) Re-pen (10 pts.)

All levels: the remaining Sheep are held off Paddock Gate then exhausted.

1st Tie Breaker: Bridge work

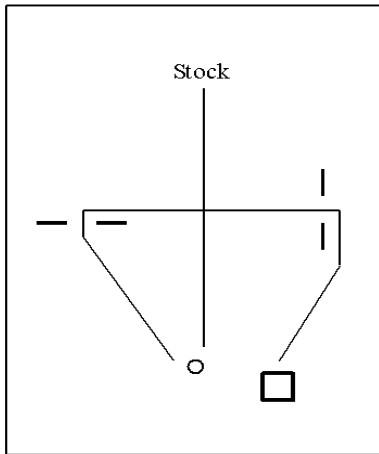
2nd Tie Breaker: The Sort

HERDING TRIAL DOG COURSES

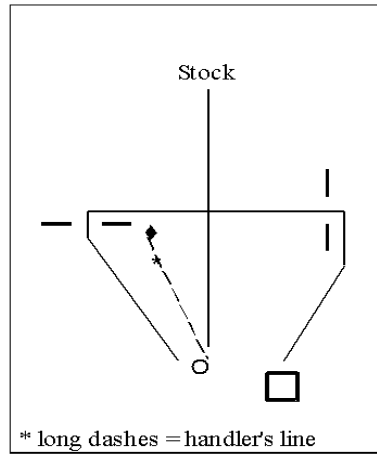

The outrun may be done in either direction at all three levels.



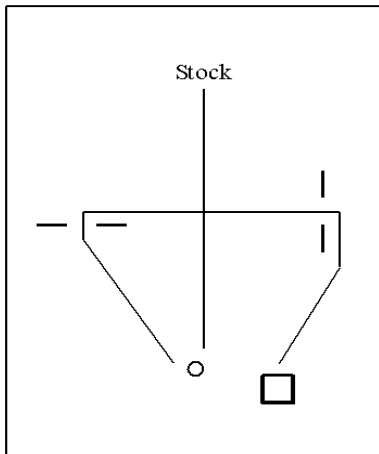
HTD I

For the gather, the dog is placed along the centerline at a point no closer to the stock than the first set of panels; the handler may move closer to the stock.



HTD II

For the gather, the dog is set out near the post; the handler may move forward but not past the panels. After moving the stock around the post and to the obstacle, the handler remains here ♦ or anywhere behind the handler's line while the dog moves the stock through the second obstacle.



HTD III

For the gather, the dog is set out near the handler's post. The handler remains at the post until time to go to the pen.
