The outrun distance for course B is the minimum for all classes.

Each day only 18 course "D" runs with groups of 10 sheep will be available with optional obstacles of gate sort, mock footpath, maltese cross or figure 8 and extra obstacles as allowed.

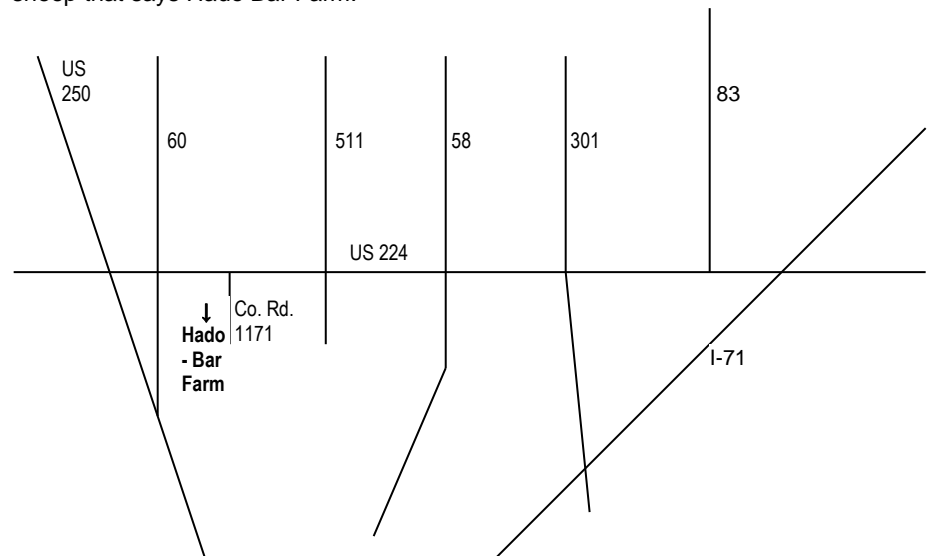

competing. Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere
outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the
AKC Herding Regulations. **YOU MUST CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS.**
