ABOUT THE HERBALS

Our first stockdog was purchased in the mid-80's, and gradually the switch was made to training herding dogs. Kent got into competitive herding trials in 1989.

Our focus here at the XP Ranch is on training dogs for ranch or trial work, and teaching students across the US to train and handle their own dogs. We also trial on cattle and sheep, and occasionally judge competitive trials. We have qualified for, and competed at the National Cattle-dog Association National Finals since 2014. Kent has won Open and Open Ranch Championships at the Houston and San Antonio Stock Shows. He has also won Grand Champion, as well as several Reserve Grands at the Denver National Western Stock Show. We train and trial both Aussies and Border Collies.

Kent is well known for his ability to read and understand a large variety of dog breeds and their handlers as well as livestock, and is a great communicator and educator. We travel approximately 60,000 miles per year competing, judging, instinct testing and instructing at clinics throughout the U.S.

Saturday, November 9, will focus on **Novice handlers and dogs**.

If you think you are interested in herding but aren't sure how to get started, or you are beginning your dog in training, this is the day to attend. There will be 10 working spots and 4 auditing spots available.

Sunday and Monday, November 10-11, the focus will be on **advanced handlers and dogs**. There will be 8 working spots and 4 auditing spots available. All training will be done on sheep.

The cost will be \$175 for the Novice clinic/one day of the Advanced clinic or \$325 for both days of the advanced clinic. The cost to audit is \$50/day. We will be starting at 8:00 am due to the limited amount of daylight in November. Breakfast will be available at 7:00 am and lunch will be served during the mid-day break. Water, hot drinks will be available all day.
