- This trial shall be run under all AHBA rules and regulations.

- All dogs 9 months of age or older may participate in Trials
- Use the official AHBA entry form
- Each individual is responsible for any damage caused by himself, his family or his dog while in the trial arena or on the trial grounds. Livestock replacement costs: Ducks - \$75, Goats -350.00, Sheep - \$300.00 (IOC retains animal). AHBA, 4 the DOGS, Isles of Calais and all trial workers assume no responsibility for any accident or injury.
- Bitches in season will run last. They should be crated away from trial arenas when not competing. Please let trial secretary know so run order can be adjusted.
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing.
- Entry confirmation will be sent by email; please be sure to include your email address.
- Trial committee will determine run order prior to the trial.
- Entry fees will only be refunded if request is received before pre-entry closing date.

HTAD COURSE #5

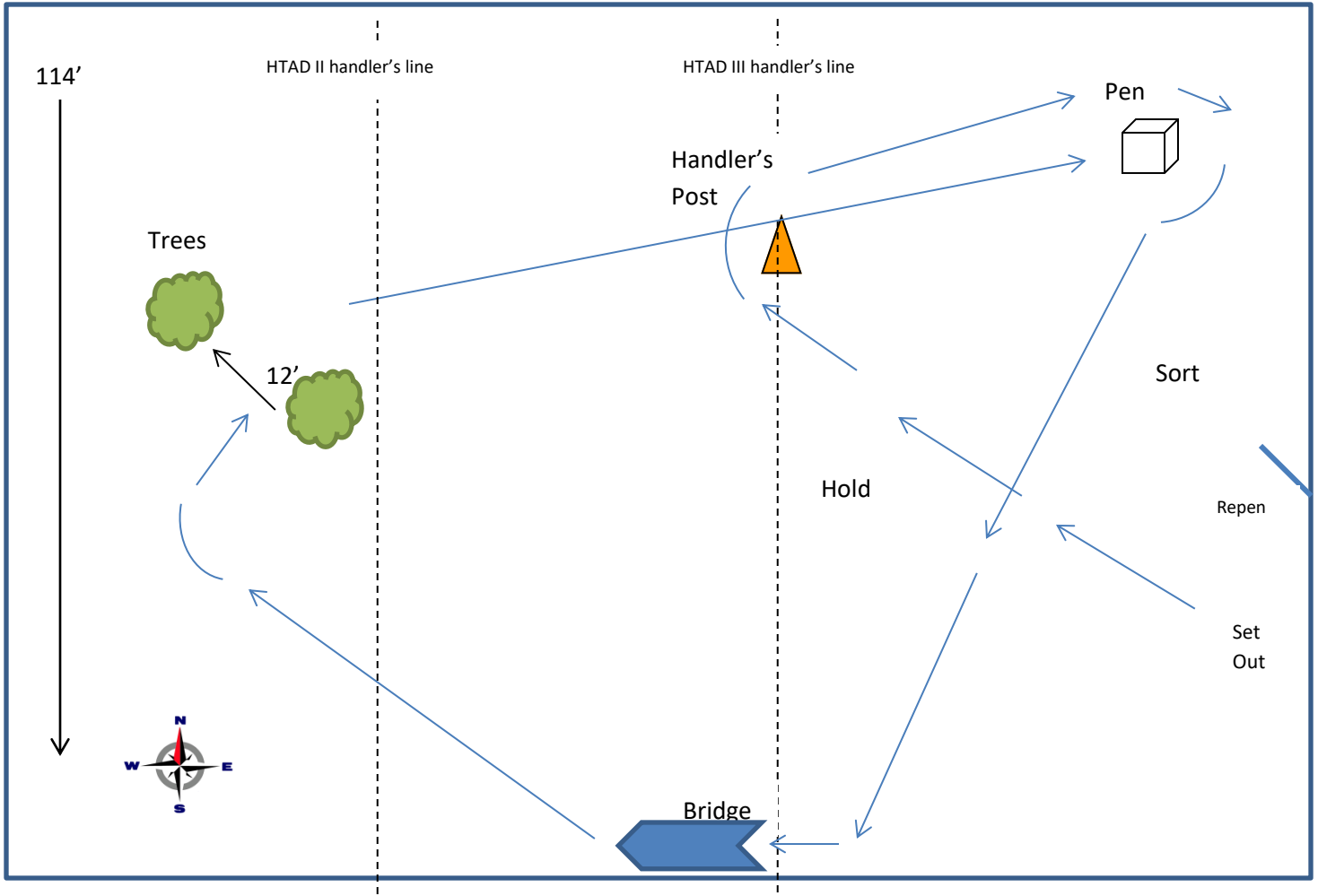
Stock set out indicated on diagram. Handler's post is located 120' from stock set out area. The bridge is 4 feet wide and 15 feet long. The tree closest to the west is 20 feet from the fence line and the space between trees is 12'. The free-standing pen is 20' from the north fence and 30' from the east fence.

1. Gather: Dog gathers stock. Positioning of dog and handler as in all other HTAD courses. Stock is brought to and clockwise around the post. Gather ends when stock has passed the post.
2. Drive: Stock are taken east between the north fence and the pen, around the pen, to a point just in front of the pen gate. Stock are driven to the bridge. HTAD III handlers remain in front of the pen. HTAD II handlers may move up halfway to bridge. HTAD I handlers may move to opening of bridge.
3. Obstacle 2 (Bridge): Stock are brought to and over the bridge. Once stock has crossed the bridge, all handlers are free to move but must remain behind handlers line as indicated for level II and III. Scoring ends when stock have exited the bridge.
4. Obstacle 2 (Trees): Upon exiting the bridge, the stock are taken between the trees. Handlers remain behind the designated handlers lines. while stock are taken through the opening between the trees. Level I handlers may go up to the trees but should not precede the stock through the trees. Once stock have exited the trees, handlers are free to move. Stock are turned toward the east and onto a line leading to the pen. Scoring ends when stock are past the level of the trees.
5. Obstacle 3 (Pen): The stock are penned in the free-standing pen. Scoring for the pen ends when the pen gate is closed.
6. Hold: Stock are taken to the hold area, settled and briefly held in place. The judge signals the end of the hold. Level I & II handlers then take the stock to repen. Level III handlers proceed with the sort.
7. Sort: Level III only. Gate sort/Ribbon removal/Shed (judge's choice)
8. Stock are taken to the repen, held a short distance off the gate while it is opened, and then repened. Run ends when gate is closed.

Tie Breakers: 1) Best gather 2) Best Repen 3) Time

Herding Ranch Dog Course (new for 2021)

Collect/control: Collect and control 10 sheep which are in Arena 1.

Chute/Foot Bath: Sheep are moved to and through chute with footbath. Level III handlers must remain behind (north of) handlers line. Level II handlers may move to the opening of the chute. Level I handlers can move along the outside of the chute. All handlers may move when sheep have exited the chute.

Sort: Sort 5 sheep into Arena 2. Level III handlers must sort the 5 sheep marked with a ribbon. Level I and II sort any 5 sheep.

Pen: Move 5 sheep into freestanding pen. Simulate medicating a sheep by removing a ribbon (level III) or gently touching sheep head with crook (level I and II).

Regroup: Gather remaining 5 sheep from Arena 1 and move them into Arena 2. Remove 5 sheep from pen and regroup.

Drive: Drive sheep from pen opening, through trees and toward hay. Level III handlers must stay at pen during the drive. Level II handler may move half-way toward trees. Level I handler may move to assist dog as needed.

Sheep are moved on to hay for the graze. Judge calls the graze. Handler then positions self and dog for gather.

Gather: Gather sheep from hay and fetch to handler's post. Level III handler sends dog from handlers' post and remains there for gather. Level II handler leaves dog at handler post and may move half way up for gather. Level I handler may leave dog half way and move up to within 15 feet of the sheep. Sheep are moved clockwise around the handler's post.

Bridge: Sheep are taken to and across the bridge. Level III handlers remain at handler's post. Level II handlers may move up halfway toward bridge entrance. Level I handlers may move to bridge opening. All handlers may move when sheep have exited the bridge.

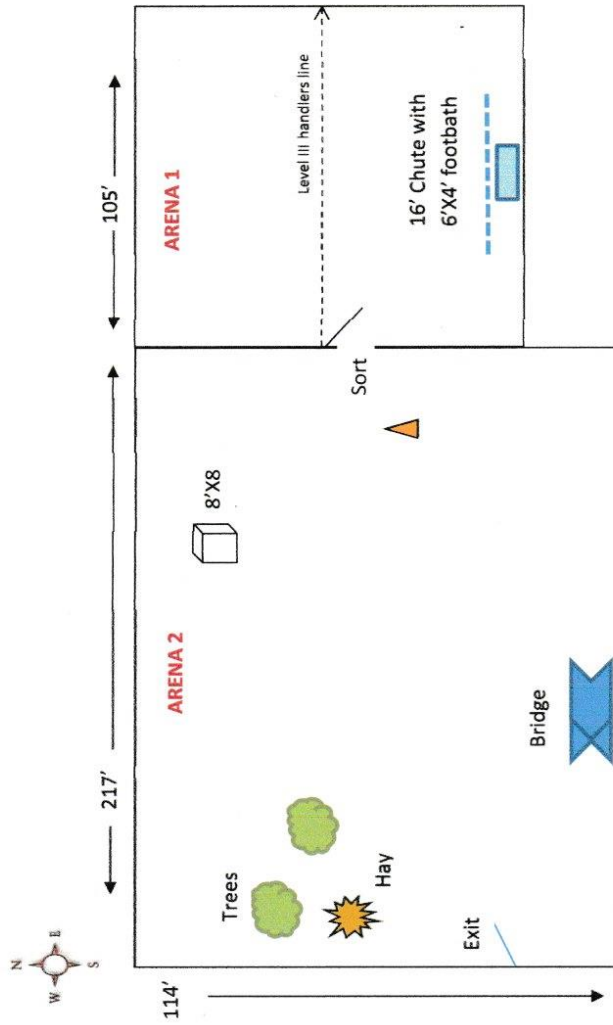
Repen: Sheep are taken to the gate and exited into the barn stall.

Time Limit: Level III—20 minutes. Level I & II—15 minutes.

Tie breaking elements: Gather, then Sort, then Time

HERDING RANCH DOG COURSE (new for 2021)

1. Collect and control sheep in arena 1 (10 sheep)
2. Chute w/footbath
3. Gate Sort of 5 sheep
4. Pen 5 sheep, pull ribbon
5. Regroup 10 sheep into Arena 2
6. Drive/Fetch from pen through trees
7. Hold sheep to graze on hay
8. Gather to handler's post
9. Across bridge
10. Exit into barn stall

No dog may be entered in two classes on the same course with the same kind of stock under the same judge at any Test/Trial. Bitches in season shall run last.
