- This trial shall be run under all AHBA rules and regulations.

- All dogs 9 months of age or older may participate in Trials
- Use the official AHBA entry form
- Each individual is responsible for any damage caused by himself, his family or his dog while in the trial arena or on the trial grounds. Livestock replacement costs: Ducks - \$75, Goats -350.00, Sheep - \$300.00 (IOC retains animal). AHBA, 4 the DOGS, Isles of Calais and all trial workers assume no responsibility for any accident or injury.
- Bitches in season will run last. They should be crated away from trial arenas when not competing. Please let trial secretary know so run order can be adjusted.
- All dogs must be on leash when not competing.
- Entry confirmation will be sent by email; please be sure to include your email address.
- Trial committee will determine run order prior to the trial.
- Entry fees will only be refunded if request is received before pre-entry closing date.
- Outdoor event – Rain or shine

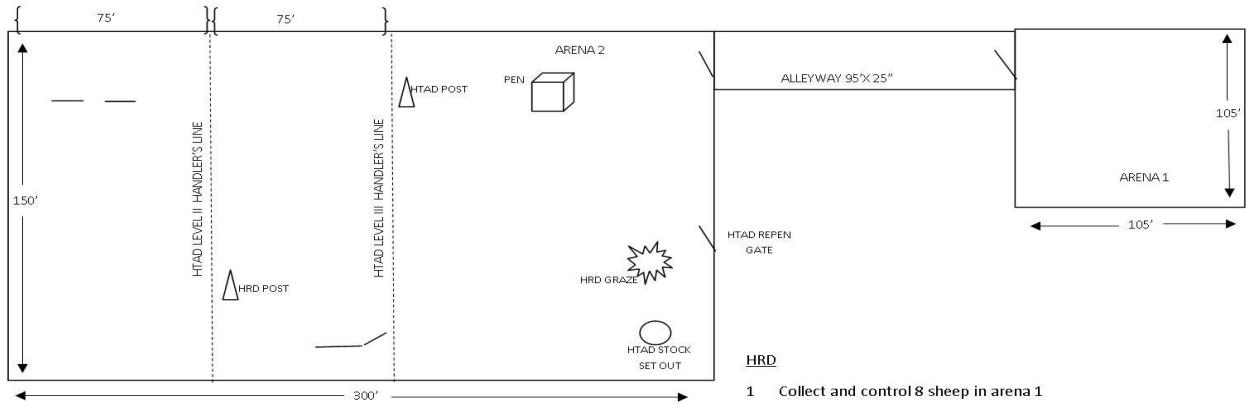
1. ARENA 1 (10 pts) – Collect and control 8 sheep in Arena 1. Leash is removed when dog enters the arena. HRD III handlers remain at gate. HRD II handlers may enter the arena with the dog but should not move the stock themselves. HRD I handlers may enter the arena and assist the dog if needed in moving the stock
2. SORT (10/15 pts) – 3 sheep are gate sorted into alley way and moved into Arena 2. HRD III sorts marked sheep
3. PEN (10 pts) – 3 sheep are penned
4. ARENA 1 (10 pts) –Remaining 5 sheep are removed from Arena 1, moved through alleyway into Arena 2 and moved to graze on hay.
5. REGROUP (5 PTS) – Remove 3 sheep from pen and regroup on graze. Judge calls graze
6. GATHER (15pts) – Gather sheep to handler’s post turning them around post clockwise. In HRD III, the handler remains at the post while the dog is sent from there to gather the stock. In HRD II, the handler may leave the dog at the handler’s post and move to a point approximately halfway between the post and the stock, then send the dog to gather the stock. In HRD I, the handler may leave the dog at a point approximately halfway between the post and the stock and move to approximately 15 ft. from the stock, then send the dog to gather the stock.
7. DRIVE (10/15 pts) - Sheep are driven toward freestanding panels. HRD III handler’s remain at post. HRD II may move up half way to panels. HRD I may accompany the sheep up to the panels but should not precede the sheep through the obstacle
8. PANEL OBSTACLE (10 pts) - Sheep are moved through the freestanding panels, moving south to north. When stock have cleared the obstacle, all handlers are free to move
9. REPEN (10 pts) – Sheep are exited from arena through alleyway and into Arena 1.

Time limit: Level I and II – 20 minutes. Level III – 25 minutes

Tiebreakers: 1) Gather 2) Sort 3)Time

HTAD

- 1 Gather
 - 2 Drive
 - 3 Obstacle 1 (Y-chute)
 - 4 Obstacle 2 (Freestanding panels)
 - 5 Hold
 - 6 Sort—Ribbon pull (HTAD III only)
 - 7 Re-Pen
- * Note—All of HTAD is run in Arena 2)

HRD

- 1 Collect and control 8 sheep in arena 1
- 2 Sort 3 sheep into alleyway and move them into arena 2 (HRD III marked sheep)
- 3 Pen 3 sheep in free standing pen
- 4 Return to arena 1, move 5 sheep through alleyway and onto graze
- 5 Remove 3 sheep from pen and regroup on graze
- 6 Gather, clockwise around post
- 7 Drive to panels
- 8 Freestanding panels
- 9 Re-pen into alleyway
